BACKGROUND:

DISCUSSION:


November 2022 total monthly system ridership was 1,917,246, an increase of 31.4% over November 2021. The total monthly bus ridership was 1,579,979 an increase of 29.1% over November 2021. The total monthly light rail ridership in November 2022 was 337,267, an increase of 43.5% over November 2021. November 2022 recorded an overall system ridership decrease of 8.9% over October 2022.

The system ridership (bus and light rail) in November 2022 is approximately 31% less compared to pre-pandemic levels. The calendar year-to-date system ridership (January-November) is 41% less than the same period in 2019 (pre-pandemic).

Levi's Events: There were two major events at the Levi's stadium in November 2022. The average ridership from the events was about 9,800 riders. The events were from two 49ers' games.
