SUBJECT: Tunnel Boring Machine Order for VTA's BART Silicon Valley Phase II Extension

Please see the attached news release announcing the order for the tunnel boring machine (TBM), a significant milestone in VTA's BART Silicon Valley Phase II (BSVII) Extension Project.

In December 2022, the VTA Board of Directors authorized the issuance of amendments to VTA's BSVII Contractor, Kiewit Shea Traylor, for early work packages including the procurement of the TBM. The not to exceed amendment total for these packages was \$460,000,000 and included the purchase of the TBM, associated TBM support activities, construction of the west portal, and Downtown San José Station enabling works.

The purchase of the TBM is not only a key milestone for the project, it creates an important momentum for this critical project and generates excitement for the community, the agency and all who are delivering this project.

VTA Board of Directors and Advisory Committee Members:

During the summer, the Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority (VTA) conducted a series of pop-up events, an online survey, and a station walk audit to identify recommendations and projects to improve how people get to and from the Berryessa/North San Jose Transit Center and Winchester Station. VTA is following up to share what we learned and provide the opportunity to give feedback on proposed station access recommendations.

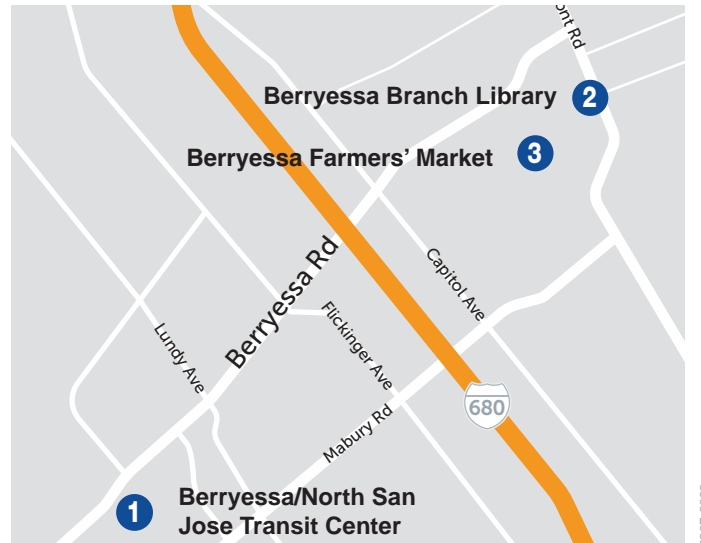

SUBJECT: VTAAlerts report on the River Oaks Campus

Last night at approximately 7:45 pm, our Allied Universal CCTV monitoring staff received a VTAAlerts report from an anonymous source from an unknown location, warning of a possible armed intruder on the River Oaks Campus.

At the time of the incident, a Bicycle Pedestrian Advisory Committee meeting was taking place in B-106. The building was immediately evacuated as a precaution, while security officers and Sheriff's Transit Patrol deputies did a thorough search of the entire campus and the interior of each building. No intruder was found, and subsequent messages on VTAAlerts from the same source were determined to be false reports and that there was never a legitimate threat to VTA employees and guests.

VTA leadership and security take every potential threat seriously. An investigation into this incident is continuing, but the River Oaks campus is considered to be free of any threat at this time. We urge everyone to download the VTAAlerts app and remain vigilant to report any suspicious activity.
