To present the bus and light rail ridership performance of the Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority.

The report is an information item and will have no impact on climate change.


DISCUSSION:

August 2024 total monthly system ridership was 2,441,088, an increase of 7.1% over August 2023. The total monthly bus ridership was 2,039,224, an increase of 10% over August 2023. The total monthly light rail ridership in August 2024 was 401,864, a decrease of 5.3% over August 2023. The average weekday system ridership for August 2024 increased by 7.9%. The Calendar year-to date (January 2024 through August 2024) system ridership (bus and light rail) was 18,486,105, an increase of 13.6% compared to the same period last year and is at about 79% of pre-pandemic ridership.

Levi's Events: There was only one event at the Levi's Stadium in August 2024. The San Francisco 49ers faced the New Orleans Saints in a pre-season game that recorded13,256 riders.
