

# CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

# October 28 to November 27, 2024

The following activities are taking place on Capitol Expressway, weather and conditions allowing.

#### **WHAT**

- · Pile driving, form columns
- · Falsework installation
- Underground utility work
- · Installation of new curb, sidewalk, and gutter
- Potholing
- Begin relocating southbound Ocala BRT station

#### **WHERE**

 In the median of Capitol Expressway, northbound from Ocala Avenue to Story Road, and southbound from Cunningham Avenue to Quimby Road.

#### **WHEN**

- Pile driving Monday to Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- Temporary lane closures, 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
- Overnight lane closures from 10:00 p.m. 6:00 a.m.

#### PEDESTRIANS & BIKE RIDERS

- Intermittent sidewalk closures, with protected pathways or detours for pedestrians.
- Flaggers will assist pedestrians, bike riders, and motorists at intersections when crews are working.
- · Bike riders may consider alternate routes.



### **EXPECT**

- Nighttime noise from back-up alarms
- Potential traffic delays due to lane closures
- · Speed limit is 35mph
- Fines are doubled in the construction zone
- Noise and vibration during the day from pile driving

## **TRAFFIC**

Intermittent 1-lane closures, Northbound and southbound Capitol Expressway, from the Alum Rock Transit Center on Capitol Avenue to the Eastridge Transit Center. Intermittent overnight 2-lane closures, in both directions from Story Road to Tully Road along Capitol Expressway. These temporary closures may also occur at various locations, either direction, for underground sanitary sewer or drainage work.

#### **BUS STOP**

- During this stage of construction, the stop for the southbound buses 70/522 (to the Eastridge Transit Center) has been temporarily relocated to the southbound Capitol Expressway near (or before) the Ocala intersection. Bus riders can access this stop by walking northbound and crossing Ocala Ave.
- The Southbound Ocala Bus station (BRT) will be temporarily dismantled to allow for roadwork. It will be reassembled in Spring, 2025.
