- Allocation through FY25: \$436.2M
- Expenditure through January 2025: \$167.7M



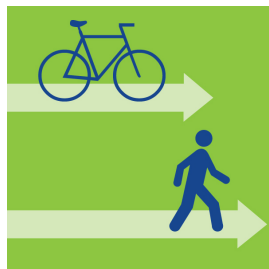
BART PHASE II

- Expenditure through January 2025: \$462.8M



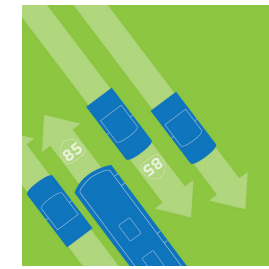
COUNTY EXPRESSWAYS

- Expenditure through January 2025: \$29.5M



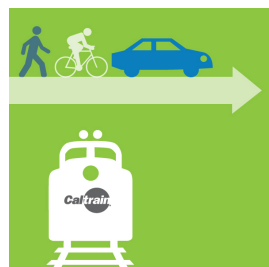
BICYCLE & PEDESTRIAN

- Expenditure through January 2025: \$18.1M



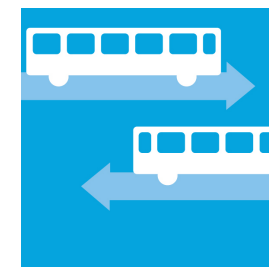
SR 85 CORRIDOR
