SCOPE OF WORK

Examine VTA's agreements with other public agencies for the provision of transportation services, which are both numerous and complex, for the risks they pose to VTA. Examples include the agreements with Caltrain, the Altamont Corridor Express (ACE), Monterey-Salinas Transit, etc. Among the factors that will be evaluated are:

- Adequacy and effectiveness of policies and procedures for negotiating and monitoring agreements
- Controls in place to ensure VTA is paying only its fair share in multi-jurisdictional agreements
- Contractual financial obligations and overall financial risk to VTA, both current and long-term
- Process for regular Board review of agreements on an ongoing basis
